Synod convened this morning at 8:00 am in First PRC, Grand Rapids, MI.

Committee 1: Rev. Eriks, Rev. Key, Elder Gary Lanning, Elder Hilgard Goosen, and Prof. Gritters. This committee will bring advice regarding foreign missions, synodical deputies, and the protest of Mr. Henry Kamps.

Committee 2: Rev. Haak, Rev. Laning, Elder Kevin Van Overloop, Alan Meurer, and Prof. Cammenga. This committee will bring advice regarding the work of the Theological School Committee, the Student Aid Committee, the Special Committee to Assist Hope PRC, and the overture from Hull PRC.
