Connors has served as a minister of the gospel in the EPC since his graduation from the Protestant Reformed seminary in 1994. The Presbytery accepted his resignation from the Brisbane charge and declared Rev. Connors to be emeritus. He will be supported financially by the Presbytery for a period of twelve months in the hope that God will grant recovery and enable him to take up the work of the ministry once again. Let us remember Rev. Connors and the EPCA in our prayers in this time of great need.
