**Books:** We have a large selection of biographies at RBO. Although you will find that some of them contain doctrines that we do not consider Biblical, we can all read and learn from the lives of these women who desired to live for the Lord.

Consider reading one of these biographies on the lives of Christian women:

**Margaret Paton - Letters from the South Seas** - This book consists of letters of Margaret, wife of John Paton Presbyterian missionary in the New Hebrides in the South Pacific near Australia in the mid to late 1800's. You will read of the joys and sorrows of family life and church life in a country far from their home in Scotland.

**My Heart in His Hands - Ann Judson of Burma** by Sharon James. Ann was one of the first two American women to go with their husbands who were missionaries to foreign lands. This book tells of Ann Judson's life with selections from her Memoir and letters in the late 1700's early 1800's. It is of special interest since Burma is now Myanmar.

**Ladies of the Reformation** by J.A. Alexander From France, Germany, England and the Netherlands, this book contains short biographies of 15 women of the Reformation including sections on the wives of John Calvin, John Knox, Martin Luther and Zwingli. There is a section on three women of the Reformation who were martyred for their beliefs. A difficult, but encouraging book to read and think on.

**Kitty My Rib** by E.J. Mall Classified as 'fictionalized biography', this book tells the story of Katherine van Bora, a nun influenced by the teachings of Martin Luther (who aides her and other nuns in escaping the nunnery) and their eventual marriage. An easy, very interesting book, giving the reader a look at not only Katherine, but also Martin Luther and his life.

**Elizabeth Prentiss – More Love to Thee** by Sharon James This is a biography of the wife of a Presbyterian minister in New York in the 1800's, who herself wrote many books. It tells of the life of a godly woman facing spiritual struggles which confront many women of today.
