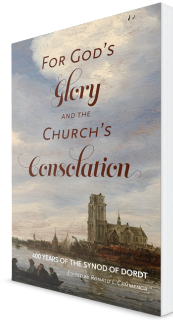

The 400th anniversary of the Synod of Dordt (1618–19) is second in importance only to the 500th anniversary of the Reformation (1517) for Reformed Christians. Indeed, marking the anniversary of the “great synod,” as it soon was called, is commemoration of the Reformation, for Dordt was the preservation of the gospel of God’s sovereign grace, which was restored to the church through the Reformation.

This powerful book defends and promotes the Bible’s teachings on particular salvation as systematized in the *Canons of Dordt* (1618-1619) with special focus on the gospel call, the covenant, reprobation and assurance. It also covers the significance, polemics, sessions and church polity of Dordt.

The chapters of this book were written by Prof. Douglas Kuiper, Rev. Angus Stewart, Prof. Brian Huizinga, Rev. Mark Shand, Rev. William Langerak, Prof. Ronald Cammenga and Prof. Barry Gritters.

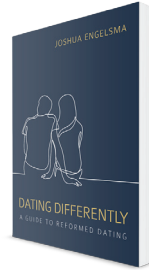
